Admissions Policy and Deadlines

Garden Nursery School provides equal opportunity for admission to all applicants without regard to race, religion, national origin or family structure. In addition, Garden Nursery School does not evaluate applicants, because we believe that all children deserve a warm, nurturing preschool experience. Thus, although priority is given to current GNS families and alumni as well as the families of GNS staff, all other applications received by the deadline are entered into a lottery for the remaining spaces.

- * We begin accepting applications at our first **Open House**, held **November 12, 2011** from 10 a.m. to noon.
- * Applications may be submitted by hand or by mail.
- * **Applications are due by February 10, 2012.**
- * Families will be notified of enrollment decisions and wait list status by **February 24, 2012.**
- * Accepted families will be required to return a contract and deposit by **March 16, 2012.**

Garden Nursery School is a Cooperative.

Garden Nursery School is founded on the belief that active parental involvement helps to establish community and, therefore, naturally eases the transition for our children as they make their way in their new school environment. Parental involvement in school shows your child you value this experience. In addition to these benefits, being involved in the GNS community is a lot of fun!

Parental participation is essential at Garden Nursery School. The following is a list of family responsibilities during the school year:

1. Parent-teaching in the classroom 5-8 times per year.
2. Participation in at least 2 fundraising events (usually held on Saturdays) or other fundraising endeavors.
3. Participation in at least 2 school clean-ups (usually held on Saturdays).
4. Attendance of parent-teacher training (one evening in the beginning of the academic year) and all General Meetings (3 per year, held on Wednesday evenings).
5. Fulfillment of a year-long cooperative job (one per family). Each family is encouraged to hold a Board position for at least one year during their time at GNS; Board members attend one Wednesday evening meeting per month.

Cooperative jobs require different amounts of time and attention. While we attempt to match families' skills and preferences with their cooperative jobs, this is not always possible. No matter what cooperative job a family is assigned they are expected to meet the jobs demands.
